"Youth At Risk" for intervention, prevention and retention of teens experiencing peer pressure, teen pregnancy, adolescent challenges both socially and academically.

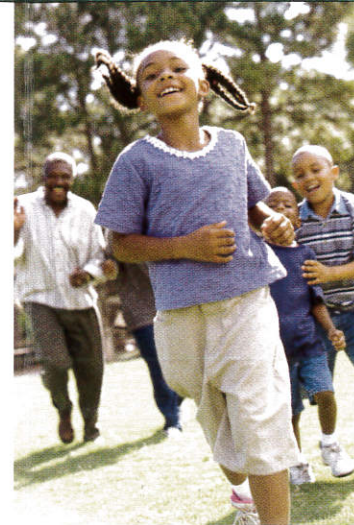
"Before and After School" to provide a caring and safe, affordable alternative for children of working parents. Transportation is offered from the Harvard Center to school and from school to the Harvard Center.

"Harvard Day Care" provides care in a nurturing, training atmosphere to give children a headstart for school.

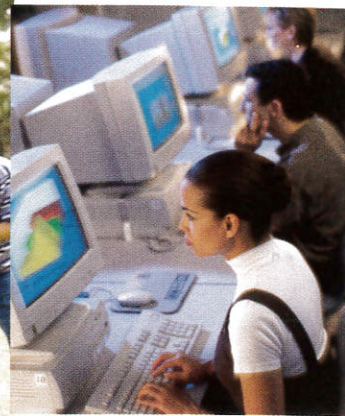
"Summer Camp" serving generations of neighborhood families with fun and educational activities.



"Moms First" work with pregnant mothers to reduce infant mortality in the City of Cleveland



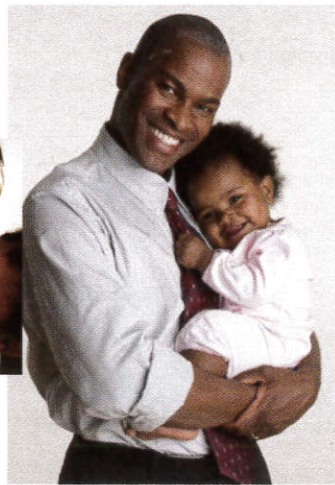
